*** Business Burglaries ***

The Williamson County Sheriff's Office is seeking the public's assistance in developing any information regarding two burglaries that occurred at a business located outside the city of Georgetown. In the early morning hours of Saturday, May 3, 2009 and again on Monday, May 11, 2009, two unidentified male subjects entered the premises and stole several thousand dollars worth of merchandise on each occasion. Taken in the burglary were numerous gas powered tools (i.e., chainsaws, leaf blowers, edger's, etc.).

Information indicates that at least two subjects were involved in these burglaries and preliminary information indicates both appear to be white or Hispanic males, late 20's to early 30's, 5'8"-6'00", 200 pounds. In each of the burglaries, the subjects wore masks to hide their face.

Information further indicates that the subjects loaded the stolen merchandise into a light colored, single-cab Ford F-150 pickup. The vehicle also had several distinct aftermarket items installed, including a bug guard on the hood, rain guards on both side windows and a mat in the bed of the truck.
