Between 1/19/2011 and 1/21/2011 unknown suspect(s) stole 14 trail lights from the Wolf Ranch Shopping Center walking trail in Georgetown, Texas. The center post and hood for the trail lights are made of copper. It is believed the suspect(s) targeted the trail lights for their copper. Valued at \$1,495.00 each

Heavy wall copper post are .125 thick. 3.5"OD. From base to top of Cap is 40"
The shade is 12" in diameter and the point of cap is a cast bronze Cap



Method of removal appears to have been by rocking them back and forth until they snapped off at base. The post may have been pulled off at that point because some internal wires were left behind still attached to concrete base.
