"On Sunday, December 11, 2011, the Georgetown Police Department received two related home invasion reports on the north and south ends of Georgetown. In both, one or two black males, medium build, with their heads covered, were reported by witnesses as suspects in their invasions.

In each incident the suspects entered the homes through unlocked doors or windows. In both reports, the suspect(s) were only interested in cash money. There are no reported injuries but both suspect(s) are considered armed and dangerous. The Georgetown Police Department has placed additional resources into investigating these incidents and increased the number of patrols in the city until the suspects are identified and/or caught.
